**DECISION OF THE ENERGY CHARTER CONFERENCE**

**Subject: Approval of the new logo**

At the meeting of the Strategy Group on 22 October 2015, Delegations discussed the offer made by The Netherlands for the use of the logo of the International Energy Charter. As explained by Minister Kamp at the opening of the Ministerial Conference on the International Energy Charter, the logo is composed of five honeycombs, which symbolise the five continents working together to create a powerful energy partnership. The logo's colours show the transition from traditional energy sources, in blue, by way of sustainable energy sources, in green, to the energy sources of the future, in yellow. The opening between the honeycombs symbolises the open market in energy that the Charter aims to promote.



At its 26<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 3 December 2015, the Energy Charter Conference **confirmed** that 2016 will be a transition year using both logos (the old logo and the new one). As of 2017, only the new logo will be used.
