Background

The Belt and Road Initiative (BRI) proposed by the President Xi Jinping has raised wide response around the various countries especially the countries along the routes and the regions, and also has become one of most important issues of foreign affairs in the report of 19th CCP Congress.

International energy cooperation is one of the most important parts within Belt and Road Initiative, for which is also a key issue to drive energy revolution. It will be helpful for development in related countries to promote energy connectivity under the framework of BRI. In September 26, 2015, President Xi Jinping attended the United Nations Development Summit at United Nations Headquarters in New York, delivered an important speech entitled "Cooperation and Win-Win Partnership for Common Sustainable Development". One of aims of BRI is to enhance the discussion on Global Energy Interconnection Development, to promote a green, clean and economical friendly way to meet the SDGs proposed by UN.

"Belt and Road Initiative" is likely to have major implications for the future of energy trade and investment across Eurasia and many other parts of the world. This is due to the fact that the initiative aims to strongly facilitate transnational energy cooperation, the development of energy infrastructure and improved market access in the regions of its direct application. Furthermore, energy connectivity under the Initiative has an important role to play within the sphere of regional economic cooperation and can facilitate increased sustainability of the international energy economy.

Rationale

Based on the successful experience of international training from the past, the Chinse Academy of Social Science (CASS) will hold *the 2nd International Seminar on Belt and Road Initiative with Global Energy Interconnection* during the period between October 14th and 26th in 2018, which is an annually program of CASS. The seminar welcome participants from countries along BRI which engaging in energy policy making, studying and industry developing. The number of participants for 2018 will be up to 35, the subjects are the Belt and Road Initiative and Global Energy Interconnection.

Main contents

The seminar will focused on the Chinese economy, international energy cooperation, global energy governance and other related issues. The main

contents include lectures and discussion, visiting related NGOs, companies and local governments.

Participants qualifications:

- 1. Participants should engage in any one of such occupations:
 - 1) Formal staff from governmental sectors related with energy;
 - 2) Formal staff from NGOs, Institutes and Universities of academic, industries and policy studies on energy;

- 3. Good health;
- 4. Participants should hand in a paper/ essay on related topics before September 30.
